## What is Title I?

Title I is a federally funded program that is designed for students who have difficulty meeting grade level academic standards and/or passing State Academic Tests.

#### Who Qualifies for Title I

- Students who are NOT certified for special education.
- Students who struggle academically and are below benchmark for grade level assessments (NWEA, classroom/grade level assessment).
- Students who performed below grade level on State Academic Tests (MSTEP).

Students are able to be dismissed from Title I programs once criteria is met.
